

Priser på PPE kits og analyser oplyst fra LGC pr 16.12.21

1. The **cost of the PPE kit is £36** and includes 6 months storage; at any point during the 6 month period the veterinary practice OR the Danish Veterinary Association can request sample analysis at additional cost.
2. The cost of **pre-purchase blood screen analysis is £256**.
If sample analysis is requested, the sample will be analysed and remaining sample will be returned to the freezer for the remainder of the 6 month storage period.
If the sample is reported as negative the sample will be disposed of at the end of the 6 month storage period, regardless of whether the sample was analysed or not.

The PPE **blood screen analysis** includes, but is not limited to, NSAIDs, Sedatives and Synthetic Corticosteroids; the turnaround time is 7 working days. It is also possible to choose a “fast track” NSAID screening: £256. The turnaround time is 4 working days.

3. The cost of **qualitative** confirmatory analysis is £949 and the cost of quantitative confirmatory analysis is £1771
A **quantitative** confirmatory analysis will only apply if the type of substance seen is subject to an International Threshold.
Confirmatory analysis will only be requested on a sample that has provided a screening finding from the pre-purchase blood screen analysis.

A confirmatory analysis request form will be sent to the veterinary practice or Danish Veterinary Association (depending on who the request for analysis came from). This will state whether it is a qualitative or quantitative analysis request and detail the cost of the analysis. The veterinary practice can then discuss with the purchaser on how they wish to proceed. Depending on the decision, one of three things can happen:

- (a) Client decides not to proceed with confirmatory analysis – LGC will report on screening findings stating that confirmatory analysis did not proceed. Note, we will only state the type of drug seen on the Certificate of Analysis, not the specific drug; the veterinary practice will be invoiced £256 for the Pre-Purchase Blood Screen
- (b) Client decides to proceed with confirmatory analysis and the substance is identified – LGC will report the outcome of the confirmatory analysis, specifying the drug(s) seen. In most instances, the veterinary practice will be invoiced for a qualitative confirmatory analysis (£949). In the event of multiple analytes we reserve the right to charge for confirmatory analysis per analyte (not per sample) if your client decided to proceed with confirmatory analysis of all possible substances seen.
Please note the confirmatory price is inclusive of the initial screen price
- (c) Client decides to proceed with confirmatory analysis and the substance is not identified – the sample is reported negative as in point 2.
Please note, that in the event that confirmatory analysis of a sample results in a negative outcome, the veterinary practice will only be invoiced £256 for the original pre-purchase blood screen analysis (i.e. will not be invoiced for the confirmatory analysis).
